Dr. Sarper H. Tanli serves as Vice President of Houston Methodist Global Health Care Services (HMG), EuropeMiddle East-Africa. He has extensive experience in healthcare planning, development, operations and informatics on an international scale. Dr. Tanli worked on various start-up projects including hospitals, outpatient centers and home healthcare programs. He has worked for Harvard Medical International (HMI) and played a leading role in the planning and development of Dubai Healthcare City and its components. Dr. Tanli led several projects for Dubai Health Care City including the development of the clinical plan, licensing structure and governance models, as well as the development and execution of an Integrated Health Network and an Electronic Health Record model. Dr. Tanli also contributed to the planning and development of a 500- bed teaching hospital based and other consulting projects in the region for HMI. Upon joining HMG and establishing HMG first international presence in Dubai, he led the development, establishment and operations of the largest outpatient center in the region (The Dubai Mall Medical Centre) and its two satellite clinics. In addition, he led the development of multiple market studies, business plans and feasibility studies for hospitals in the Middle East and North Africa. He currently leads multiple developments and management relationships such as Jeddah Health Care Pak in KSA, large outpatient center in Dubai, operational commissioning of 200-bed cancer hospital, 2,600-bed healthcare complex in Istanbul, and radiation oncology centers in East Europe. More recently, Dr. Tanli also oversees education and clinical collaboration with leading teaching institutes in the region as well as consulting services in Latin America.

Gunnar Öhlén, M.D., Ph.D., Hon FESEM is Chief medical officer at the section of Quality and Patient Safety at Karolinska University Hospital. Dr Ohlen is a specialist in Orthopaedic surgery and has his Ph.D from the Karolinska Institute in Stockholm, Sweden. Dr Öhlén is the former Medical counsellor for Emergency Care in the Stockholm County and former head of the Department of Emergency Medicine at Karolinska University Hospital. Dr Öhlén is also associate professor of orthopaedics at Karolinska Institutet. His research entails spinal surgery, hip fracture treatment and emergency- and disaster medicine. He is the past president of the European Society for Emergency Medicine, EuSEM.

During a year before attending the Karolinska Institute for his basic medical training he attended Washington and Lee University in Lexington, Virginia, US studying sociology, psychology and medical ethics. During medical school he was involved in nutritional research and later during his orthopaedic training in the treatment of spinal and hip fractures. His PhD thesis was on the subject of scoliosis aetiology and treatment.

During the last 10 years he has also worked, extensively with the project for the new 600 bed University Hospital in Stockholm. During the first years of planning, he was the hospital coordinator for the whole project. His present focus in the project, is on Quality and Patient Safety in the new hospital and how to build up the care network and logistics for the patients inside and outside the hospital. His resent research has mainly focused on the handover of information in the care process, adverse drug reactions and frequent visitors to the Emergency Department.

Dr. Barbara Taušová, MBA studied medicine at the Masaryk University in Brno.
